

ISEP Founders Fellows are dedicated to language learning and improving their speaking, reading and comprehension in a foreign language as an integral part of their interest in studying abroad. The application includes a creative project or prototype, a project proposal and a personal statement.

### ISEP FRENCH & GERMAN LANGUAGE SCHOLARSHIP - \$500-1,500

With the generous support of The Annette Kade Fund, ISEP offers these scholarships to students from U.S. member institutions who plan to study French or German while abroad in Austria, France, Germany, Reunion Island or Switzerland.

# STUDY ABROAD

We directly enroll you at our member universities because we value the personal transformation that comes from cultural immersion. As an international student, you will not only grow academically and professionally, but enrich your life and open your mind to new experiences.

With ISEP, you can study abroad for a semester, full academic year or during the summer in over 50 different countries.

While ISEP offers many places where you can study abroad, there are two ways to go: **ISEP Direct** and **ISEP Exchange**. Both program types offer diverse locations and affordable options to suit your academic needs. The best program type for you depends on your home institution and your desired site.



## HOW IT WORKS

### ISEP DIRECT

When you go abroad on an ISEP Direct program, you pay the fee specified for your program, which *may even be less* than what you normally pay at your home institution.

- Meet the minimum requirements and your placement at your top choice program is guaranteed.
- Flexible options are available for housing and meals.
- Some ISEP Direct programs include special benefits like excursions, an intensive language course and more.
- ISEP Direct deadlines vary by program and are typically later to allow more time to decide on your perfect program. Check our website for details!

### ISEP EXCHANGE

When you go abroad on an ISEP Exchange program, you pay your home institution's tuition, housing and meals and take the spot of a student at another ISEP university.

- Rank up to 10 universities; placements depend on space available and are not guaranteed.
- Programs include packaged housing and meals.
- Submit your application by the priority deadlines (**Feb. 15 & Sept. 15**) to be eligible for sites with more limited spots.

### ACADEMICS & LANGUAGE

- Major cities offer a lot of attractions, but it may be easier to meet people and feel at home in a medium-size city or smaller town.



### TYPE OF INSTITUTION & HOUSING

- Small institutions may offer more personal attention; large universities may have more course options.



### PROGRAM DURATION & DATES

- Want to go abroad for a full year, a semester or during the summer? While a full-year program may seem daunting, many students come back wishing they had stayed longer!
- Due to widely differing academic calendars around the world, be sure your program fits the timeline of your home university's semester dates.
