YOUR OPTIONS WITH ISEP

ISEP Exchange

As an ISEP Exchange student, you will study at an ISEP member institution and another ISEP student will study in your place at your university. You'll pay about the same costs as you pay now and you'll receive tuition, housing, and meals abroad. When you apply, you'll list the schools you are most interested in attending and then receive a placement based on space availability.

ISEP Direct

With ISEP Direct, you can choose the program you want to attend, and placement is guaranteed if you meet the eligibility requirements. ISEP Direct also offers popular destinations not available on ISEP Exchange, including Paris, Florence, Prague, Greece, Costa Rica, and Ghana. Costs vary, but many ISEP Direct semester programs are \$16,000 or less for tuition, housing, and insurance.
